We should regard this beauty not as only enriching the eye, but also the spirit, through the fitting sacrifice the person that dedicates them offers to God.

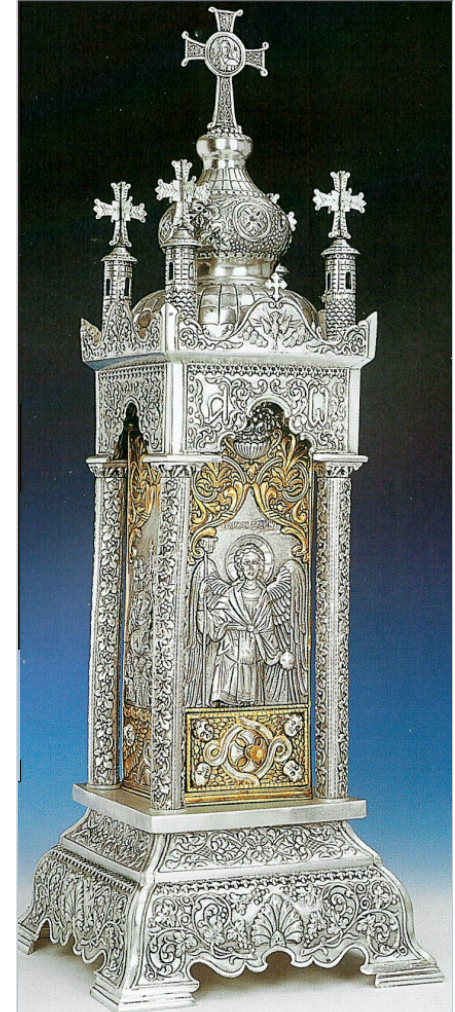

How do I dedicate an item?

Why do we need these items for the altar?

The altar represents the Kingdom of Heaven on earth, the holiest place in a church. The altar items are used for the consecration of the Eucharist, the True Body and the True Blood of our Lord Jesus Christ. Therefore these items have to be of the highest quality and the most precious materials.

Do I have to pay my entire dedication amount upfront?
