



What is included in this iconography dedications program?

All Stage One Iconography: Iconostasis, Altar Apse, Vault and Lateral Walls. See the schematic on this page to see all the components.

Can I dedicate a single saint or only an entire iconographic scene?

One can choose to dedicate an entire altar scene or just a single saint belonging to that scene.

Do I have to pay my entire dedication amount upfront?

Although cash donations are encouraged, we can set up a payment plan to fit your needs.

When do I have to decide?

We encourage people to decide fast in order to ensure that they will be able to dedicate the icon they wish before someone else commissions it.
